Accepting an Honorarium

PURPOSE

To provide guidelines to HCA employees when offered an honorarium for a speech, appearance, article, or similar item or activity in connection with their official role.

DEFINITIONS

Honorarium Money or thing of value offered to a state officer or state employee for a speech, appearance, article, or similar item or activity in connection with the state officer's or state employee's official role.

POLICY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. No HCA employee may accept an honorarium for any speech, appearance, article, or similar activity that is connected with the employee's official role.
- 2. HCA does not grant exceptions to this policy.
- 3. Reimbursement to HCA for travel expenses incurred by an HCA employee for travel and subsistence in connection with a speech, presentation, appearance, or similar activity made in an official capacity is not an honorarium and may be accepted if permitted by HCA Administrative Policy 1-07, *Accepting Gifts*.
- 4. An HCA employee may accept money or an item of economic value for a speech or other activity that is not related to the employee's official role.

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
